Together, we can continue to empower transformation, helping those facing mental illness and addiction lead healthier lives and ensure continued access to mental and behavioral health care for all.

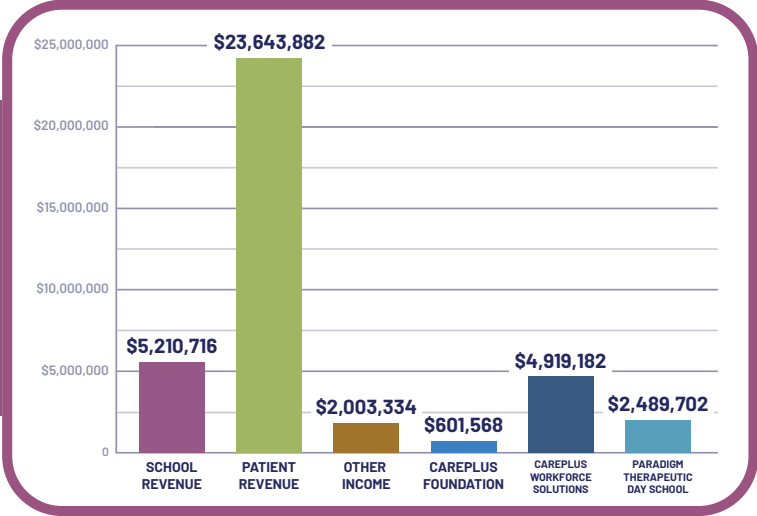

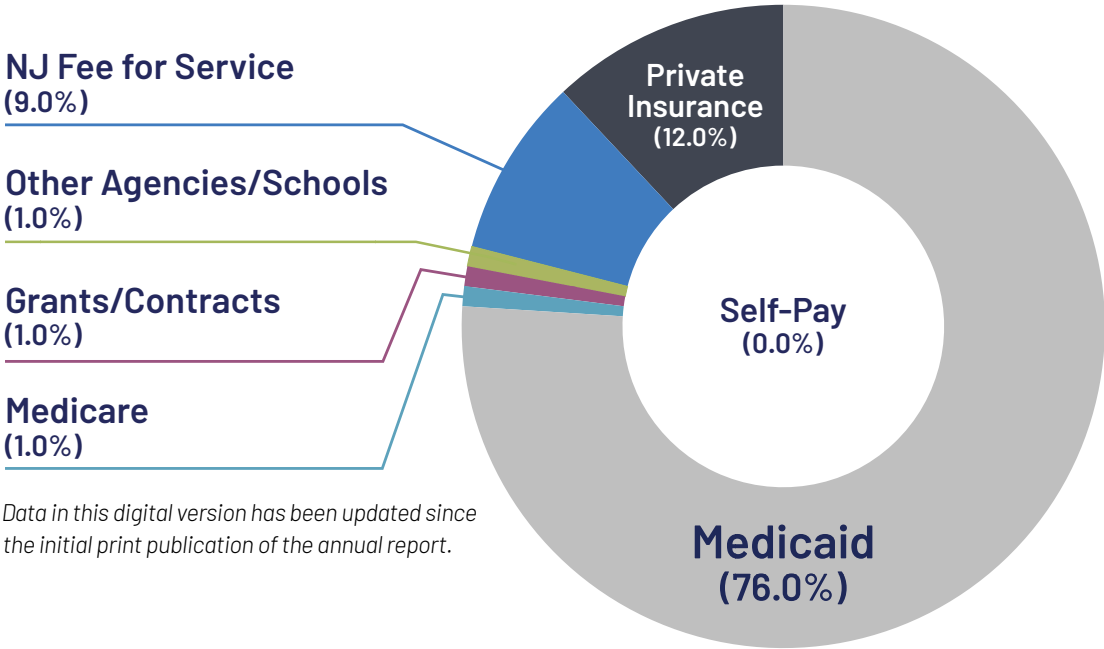

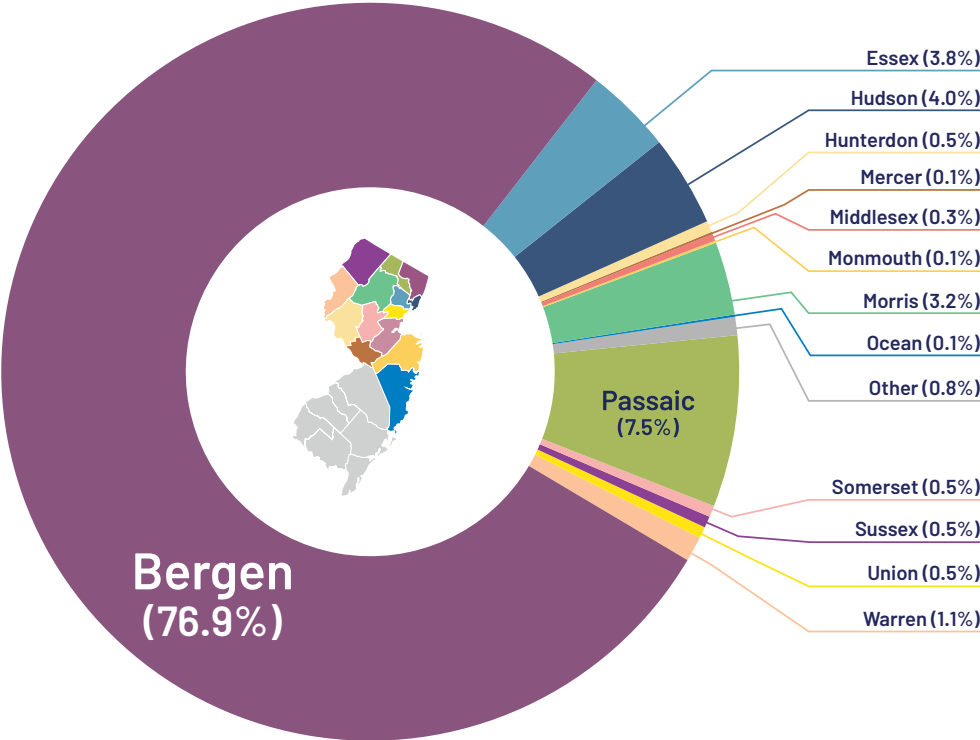

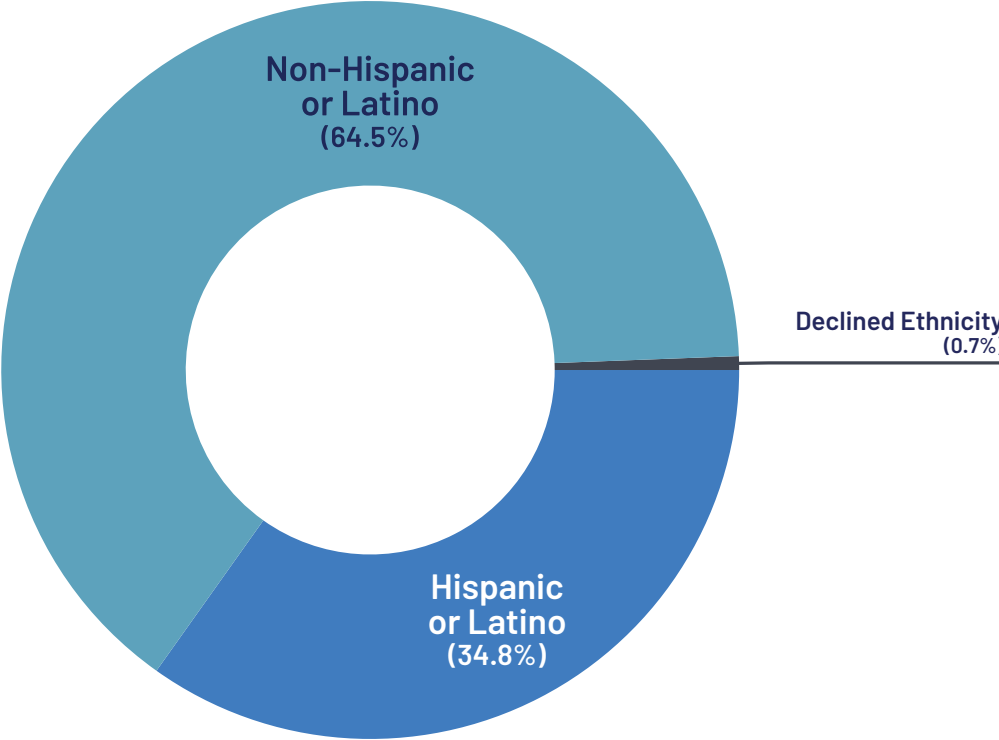

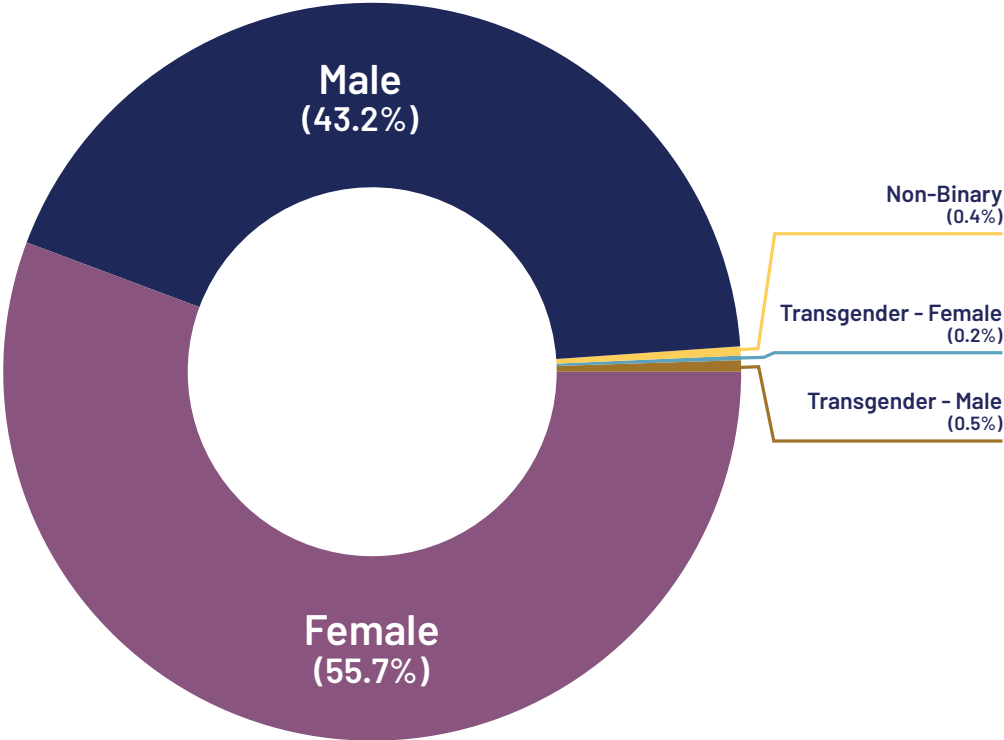

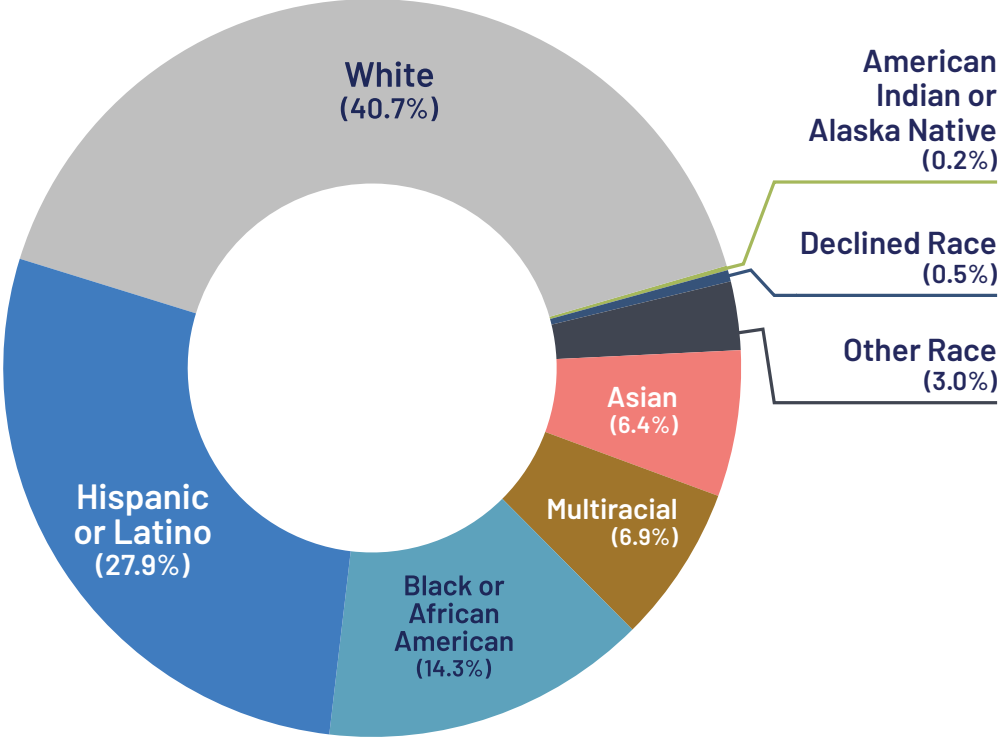

\$8M grant helps CarePlus NJ expand services to Essex County

"As one of State of New Jersey's first CCBHCs established in 2017, we are acutely aware of the critical need to enhance and expand access to integrated primary and behavioral health care, especially for historically underserved populations including communities of color and LGBTQ+ individuals," Brigitte Johnson, President and CEO, CarePlus NJ said. "The funding will allow us to build on our agency's goals of improving health equity and embedding DEIB in all areas of the organization to ensure we are continuing to enhance access to integrated care for the populations who need it most."

How CarePlus NJ shifted gears from staff questions to DEI accountability

"What I tell people is, sometimes, we think of the DEI space as just a Black-white issue, and it's so much bigger than that," she said. "For us, we're looking at health and equities and looking at how we can participate and be a part of health equity. 'Threat assessment teams' at NJ schools will identify 'students of concern'

At least 138 schools across 72 districts in Bergen County have been trained on the topic already, by CarePlus NJ's STOP School Violence Program.

"Whenever I start my trainings, I say we are not trying to train you on how to identify the next perpetrator of violence," Ashley Morolla, manager of the program, told New Jersey 101.5. "It's really meant to identify any student that needs assistance or support, at any level — hopefully at the beginning."

SCHOOL-BASED SERVICES

Performed **370 school clearance evaluations** for school districts that mandate a clearance letter for students returning to school post-incidents posing potential risks to self, others, or property. CarePlus NJ offers assessments by licensed clinicians, with **appointments in 24-48 hours**, and provides recommendations for follow-up services, including immediate school support planning calls and direct linkages to support services.

1,875 students were served through CarePlus NJ's **School-Based Services**, providing innovative solutions that address students' mental, social, and emotional health. Services include counseling, assessments, skill-building groups, and more.

The New Jersey Statewide Student Support Services (NJ4S) is a hub and spoke model that provides a multi-tiered system of support for schools, through a community, in school, and individual level of services. CarePlus NJ heads the clinical portion of the Bergen Hub in collaboration with Comprehensive Behavioral HealthCare, Vantage Health System, and West Bergen Mental Healthcare. Children's Aid & Family Services heads prevention services. Below is a quick glance of our services to date, as we end the 1st school year of operation.

School districts apply to the Hub for the tiers of support they feel are needed in their school(s). The expectation is that Tier 3 services are provided by licensed clinicians; Tier 2 services are provided by prevention consultants; and Tier 1 services are universal/general support.

281 individuals and families received counseling, support groups, and medication management through the **Maternal & Family Center at CarePlus NJ** to address perinatal mental health for women and families before, during, and after pregnancy.

THE PSYCHIATRIC EMERGENCY SCREENING PROGRAM (PESP)

The **Psychiatric Emergency Screening Program (PESP)**, which manages the **24-hour crisis hotline (262-HELP)** and offers mobile crisis response, diversion, and stabilization services for those experiencing acute psychiatric symptoms in Bergen County, **documented 33,487 crisis calls** and **served 2,089 individuals**.

2,075 youth were served through **CMRSS** which offers 24/7 crisis intervention and stabilization for youth in Bergen County. Crisis Response workers respond to youth and families in their communities, often at their homes, to meet them "where they are at."

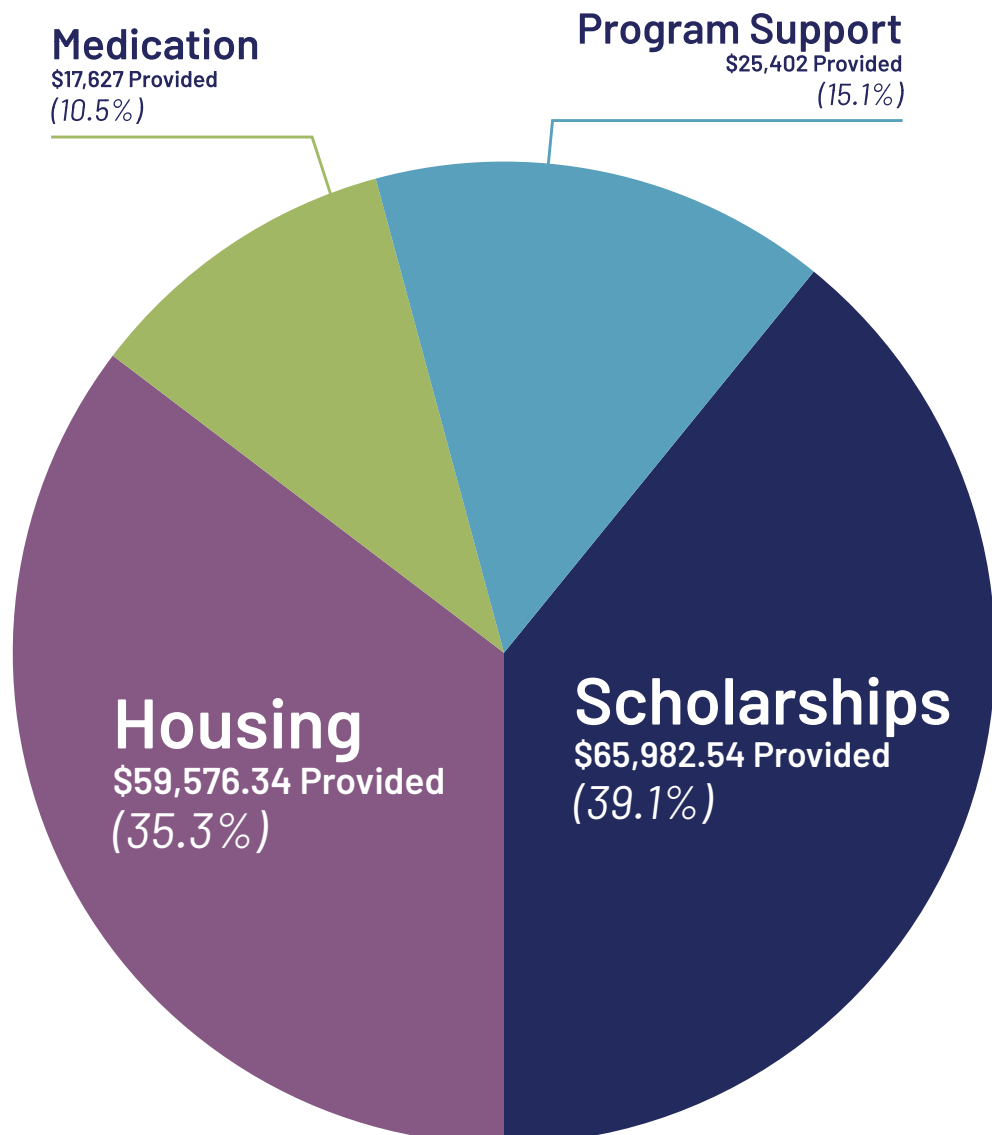

SUCCESS STORIES

DAVID'S STORY

For nearly a decade, David Ferrer and his father, Hector, faced the challenges of homelessness while managing David's developmental needs. Three years ago, Dr. Tanya Lewis referred them to Rapid Re-Housing, which secured them permanent housing. Hector commends Siobhan O'Neil, the Program Director, and her team for resolving their situation in a "timely, satisfactory, and lasting manner," while also addressing David's educational challenges and ensuring access to community resources.

He emphasizes CarePlus NJ's compassionate staff, exceptional doctors, and modern facilities, crediting Dr. Lewis and Siobhan as pivotal to their "success story." Hector describes CarePlus NJ as "life-transforming," attributing this change to its caring and proactive leadership.



KENDRA'S STORY



Kendra Asante's journey with CarePlus NJ began over a year ago, in August 2022. Back in high school, she learned about the Strive Program from her counselor, Ms. Pam, while staying at the YMCA Newark Shelter. Dreaming of becoming a nurse and obtaining her driver's license, Kendra hoped CarePlus NJ could help her achieve these goals.

Since joining CarePlus NJ, Kendra's life has transformed. She started nursing school, found a job, and her confidence has soared. Along the way, Kendra formed lasting bonds with CarePlus NJ staff, each empowering Kendra's transformation.

Maggie encouraged her after she failed her driver's permit test. With Maggie's support, Kendra passed the test. Ashley pushed her to enroll in a phlebotomy course, and Angie helped her with practical needs like getting a bed and grocery shopping.

Kendra is grateful for the housing, counseling, overall support, and especially appreciates the ShopRite gift cards, which make grocery shopping easier. Kendra's journey with CarePlus NJ is ongoing, and her future is bright. When asked about her experience, Kendra wholeheartedly recommends CarePlus NJ STRIVE Program to anyone needing help and support.
